Australiasian Council on Open Education and E-Learning Notes to the Financial Statements For the Year ended 31 December 2011

1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements are special purpose financial statements prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW). The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of the financial statements.

- (a) **Cash and Cash Equivalents** Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks, other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less, and bank overdrafts. Bank overdrafts are shown within borrowings in current liabilities on the balance sheet.
- (b) **Property, Plant and Equipment** Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

The depreciable amount of all fixed assets are depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

The depreciation rates used for each class of depreciable assets are:

Leasehold Improvements 20 % Leased Plant and Equipment 40 % Office Equipment 40 %

Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

(c) **Revenue and Other Income** Revenue from the provision of membership subscriptions is recognised on a straight line basis over the financial year.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

(d) **Trade Payables** Trade payables are recognised at their transaction price. Trade payables are obligations on the basis of normal credit terms and do not bear interest

(e) Goods and Services Tax (GST) Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with other receivables or payables in the statement of financial position.

APPENDIX B: EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

ACODE 60 Executive Officer Report - 2nd November 2012

Since the last report at the end of June the Secretariat office has been continuing to implement new accounting procedures, the result of which you will see the ACODE profit and loss statement (attachment B).

In viewing this statement the accounts show a \$55,146.30 loss, this is simply a timing issue as these accounts were begun on January 1 this year with most of the income for the 2012 memberships being accounted for in the 2011 reports, see attachment A.

ACODE are also expecting payment from the NNI of approx \$9000 for the costs associated with the NNI 2 meeting in Sydney and a further \$5000 for Secretariat support for the project.

To date all 48 institutions invoiced paid their membership fees for 2012.

ACODE Executive have met twice via Elluminate since ACODE 59 and had a full planning day yesterday, with discussions on workshop planning, NNI reports and the development of the new ACODE Website, updating the Action Plan and the Strategic Plan.

Thanks to Ric Canale for his continued support to the Executive for the Elluminate sessions.

The Secretariat has also organised and participated in the National Networking Initiative's second face to face meeting in Sydney in October. More to be reported from the President.

The Members' representative listings on the website are updated as the Secretariat receives notification and I urge you all to keep us informed of any changes.
